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Resumen:

Azul Darío es un poema sinfónico en dos movimientos, escrito entre 2016 y 2017. La instrumentación consiste en: un piccolo, dos flautas, dos oboes, un corno inglés, dos clarinetes en si bemol, un clarinete bajo, dos fagotes; cuatro cornos en fa, tres trompetas en si bemol, dos trombones tenores, un trombón bajo, una tuba; cuatro timbales y percusión menor para tres percusionistas; sección completa de violines primeros y segundos, violas, violonchelos y contrabajos.

Este poema sinfónico está basado en dos sonetos del poeta nicaragüense Rubén Darío; “Venus” y “Caupolicán” aparecen en la segunda edición del libro Azul, publicado en 1890. De ellos extraigo elementos literarios que traslado de forma libre, al texto musical; consecuentemente, la estructura evoluciona a partir del desarrollo temático.

El carácter de “Venus” es lírico, dulce, y romántico. Aquí la representación de la belleza adquiere una función primordial en la melodía, que junto a la armonía y la orquestación, refleja tanto el lenguaje impresionista del soneto, como la influencia de la literatura francesa del autor. El movimiento sigue el ritmo y la estructura heptadecasílabo del soneto, de manera casi literal en las métricas, así como en la construcción de frases melódicas.

“Caupolicán” es un movimiento de fuerza y bravura en lenguaje tonal con rasgos postonales. Tanto el carácter como la sonoridad de orquestación brillante, parte de un tema heroico que representa al personaje del soneto, guerrero mapuche del Siglo XVI. La idea de batalla, implícita en el personaje, se traduce en sensación sonora de influencia primitivista de escalas octatónicas, y métricas en amalgama. El carácter bélico se intensifica a través de todo el movimiento, con el protagonismo de la percusión y los bronce.

Azul Darío es una obra para orquesta sinfónica escrita en dos movimientos, "*Venus y Caupolicán*". Cada uno basado, de manera programática, en los sonetos homónimos del poeta nicaragüense Rubén Darío, publicados en la segunda edición del libro "*Azul*", de 1890.

Darío, siendo la figura más importante del modernismo latinoamericano, estaba fuertemente influenciado por el parnasianismo francés. Para ambos movimientos, el color azul estaba vinculado a la belleza, a lo ideal. Para Darío representaba "*el color del ensueño, un color helénico y homérico, color oceánico y firmamental*". Eduardo de la Barra, autor del prólogo de "*Azul*", debido a la admiración que Darío tenía por Victor Hugo, relacionó el título del libro a la frase del poeta francés: *I'Art, c'est I'Azur*, cuya traducción es:

El arte es azul.
